- Contractor Records Retention (FEHBAR 1652.204-70)

We will send amendments to the 2005 contract to include the new regulations by October 3, 2005. Please sign and return two copies by October 11, 2005. The amended contract clauses are included in Attachment B. We are submitting technical amendments to change the effective dates of the FEHBAR clauses to July 2005.

Please note that all carriers will be required to issue a disclosure notice under P.L. 108-173 of the Medicare Modernization Act of 2003. We have provided language for the disclosure notice in the 2006 plan brochures.
